

Waste Management and Environmental Awareness Training for ALSTOM, Power, Blackburn

The technical team at ALSTOM Power CHP, Blackburn run a continuous programme of training for the professional development of site staff. Mr Stuart Shaw (Plant Engineer) organised training with Eco-Technology Ltd as part of an exclusive lubrication management programme with Shell UK.

The key areas covered were waste management, legislation, environmental awareness and spillage response. The training was organised to fulfil mandatory requirements for all personnel to be qualified to liaise with external waste contractors and agencies, and to make effective waste management an integral part of daily operations.

The initial training group consisted of day shift technical staff and management. The feedback prompted ALSTOM to organise a second session for the remaining staff on site.

Immediately following the training the site waste management system was revised and comprehensively documented by site staff. The system was subsequently audited by Scottish Power with very positive results.

Mr Shaw commented that **"the training was, and still is, found to be interesting and well related to real life with a minimum amount of cold paperwork. The training is pointed at true site conditions and practical exercises."**
